Re: Bixby Trails Master Plan

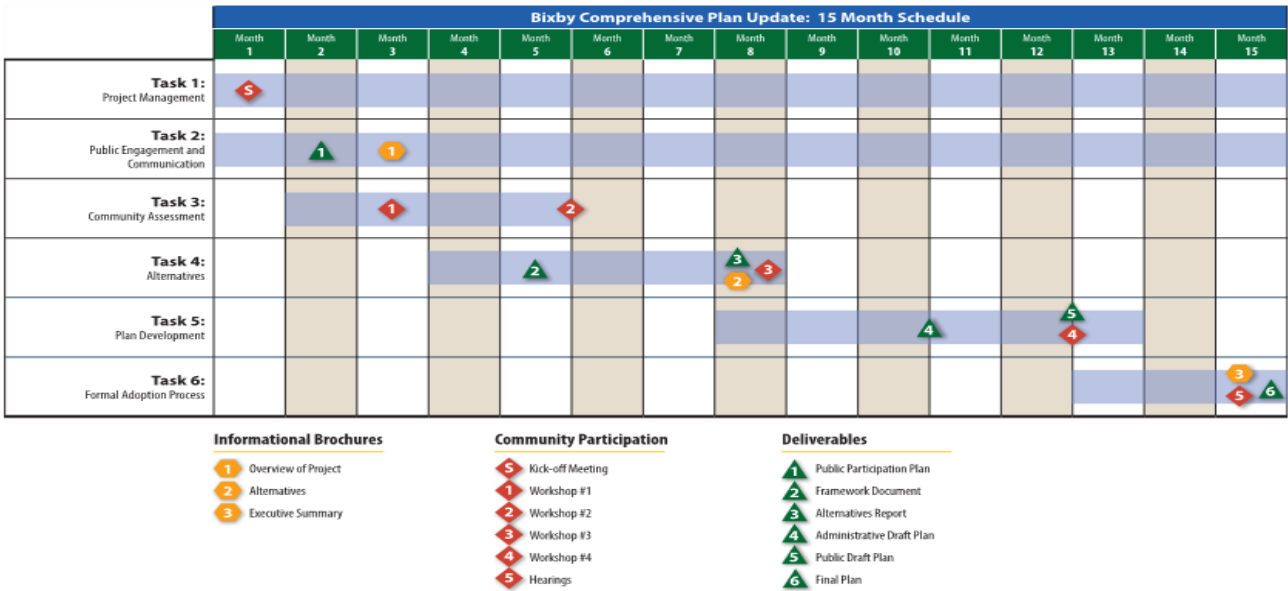
To all concerned,

I wanted to provide an update since our last public meeting concerning the extension of a new trail in your neighborhood (between 111th Street and 121st Street). In the past, many of you showed interest in possible future locations of these trails. Since then, the City Council has voted to retain the services of a consulting firm to overhaul the City of Bixby's Comprehensive Plan. This plan will specify future land uses and development throughout the City, including Trail Corridors. Utilizing this method to identify future trails in our City provides a much more permanent solution that could only be modified by a Public Hearing. The Comprehensive Plan will show Trail Corridors along Mingo from 111th Street to 121st Street as discussed during the previous Public meeting.

The only trail currently planned that has been voted on by Council and budgeted is the extension from Cross Creek (West of 128th & Memorial) to 121st Street on the South side of Twin Creeks.

We do not have a detailed work schedule from the Comprehensive Plan Consultant, but anticipate that it will generally conform to the schedule provided below. Presuming the contract is approved in February, the Public Engagement phase will likely begin in March.
